

Every year, South Carolina Talking Book Services hosts an arts event for blind and visually impaired students in our state.

It is time to enter this year's South Carolina Talking Book Services "Let's Celebrate Art!" competition!

The art competition is open to any K-12 student with blindness or visual impairment who is still attending school. Artwork can be in any medium, but it must be tactile. Only one entry is allowed per student.

There are three age categories: ages 6 to 10, ages 11 to 15, and ages 16 and up. First, second, and third place are awarded in each category. The State Librarian selects one piece to win the State Librarian Award, which will be permanently displayed in the South Carolina State Library.
